IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT HOW TO VOTE IN THE CLUB ENDORSEMENT

A Club member is eligible to vote for endorsements if they are 1. a registered Democrat living in the 14th Ward and 2. are current in their Club 2024 membership dues. **If a member paid dues in 2022 and/or 2023, the member may pay 2024 any time before March 17 or at the Endorsement Meeting.** All new members must have paid dues by 11:59pm, January 31, 2024.

If your membership is lapsed, you can renew membership at: www.pgh14widc.org. **Check the mailing label on this flyer to see the most recent year you paid dues.** Voting is online using OpaVote. One OpaVote ballot is sent to each individual email address. Each eligible household voting member must have provided their own individual email address to vote.
